


Fig. 3. Weak monsoon over Madhya Maharashtra

The study indicates that though on most of the occasions of the passage of surface or upper air lows across south Peninsula during break monsoon conditions, rainfall is scanty in Madhya Maharashtra, on the rare occasions when the upper air cyclonic circulation associated with the system extends to Madhya Maharashtra, the region may get a spell of vigorous monsoon.
